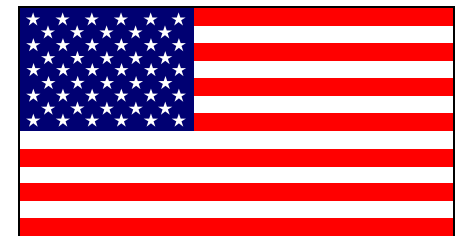

What is the Benton County Veterans Assistance Fund?

The Benton County Veterans Assistance Fund provides assistance to Benton County Veterans, their families, and the families of deceased Veterans, who meet the eligibility criteria for assistance.

What Type of Assistance Does the Benton County Veterans Assistance Fund Provide?

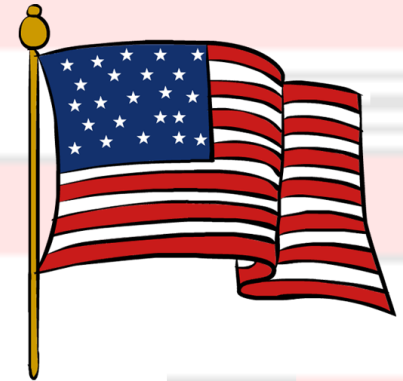
Eligible Veterans may receive assistance with past due rent, utilities, and food vouchers. Assistance for burial expenses may also be provided.



What is Required to Determine Eligibility?

- Copy of DD214 or Record of Service that shows character of service.
- Proof of current residency of Benton County; must be resident for at least 90 days unless recently discharged
- Proof of household size
- Proof of all household income which is at or below 150% of the Poverty Guidelines (low-income)
- Proof of need for assistance
- Widows or widowers must provide marriage license and veteran's death certificate

Bring all these required documents to the service times to be screened for assistance.



Qualified Veterans May Be Eligible For:

- Utility Assistance
- Food Vouchers
- Rental Assistance
- Burial Assistance
