Each of the four St. Vincent de Paul Conferences serve a different geographic area based on where you are living. If you need assistance, please contact the appropriate Conference.

◆ **St. Vincent de Paul Conference (serving Pasco)**

Our Conference is open at 215 S 6th Avenue in Pasco on Wednesdays from 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. for food and clothing distribution. A message line is available for requests outside of those hours (509 544-9315). We help with food, clothing, utilities and a representative from Catholic Family Services is on-site on Wednesdays.

◆ **St. Joseph's Parish St. Vincent de Paul Conference (serving east Kennewick & Finley)**

The St. Vincent de Paul Conference of St. Joseph Parish services Kennewick residents **east of Vancouver Street** and includes the Finley area. We offer help with food, electric bills and other needs on a case-by-case basis. In order to be able to offer help to as many as possible, we limit our services to three times per year per household. We also confer with our clients and let them know about other resources available in the Tri-Cities area. To request assistance, our helpline number is 591-0149.

◆ **Parish of the Holy Spirit St. Vincent de Paul Conference (serving west Kennewick)**

Our Conference has a message helpline for requests for assistance for those living **west of Vancouver Street**. We offer help with referrals to community resources and possible financial assistance. Clients are assisted on a personal case-by-case basis and a home visit will be required before any financial assistance can be given. Some of the needs we have helped with in the past include rent, utilities, bus passes, gas, ID and food. Our helpline number is 591-0632.

◆ **Christ the King Parish St. Vincent de Paul Conference (serving Richland, West Richland & Benton City)**
